After having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, prima facie, it appears that the impugned order dated 17.02.2026 (P-1), passed by the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Rewari, is without jurisdiction. Consequently, the collaboration agreement entered into with another builder, namely, Basanth Infratech, has become null and void. Thereafter, the order dated 20.03.2026, whereby the Managing Committee was removed by the same officer, is prima facie absolutely unwarranted and contrary to the mandate of the Constitution, as amended by the 97th Constitutional Amendment.

Notice of motion.

Since the State respondents were served with an advance copy of the petition, Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to file the written statement.

The State may file the written statement three days prior to the next date of hearing, with an advance copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the opposite party.

On her request, hearing of the case is deferred to 16.11.2026.

In the meantime, operation of the impugned orders dated 17.02.2026 (P-1) and 20.03.2026 (P-2) shall remain stayed forthwith. The Managing Committee shall be put back in position to supervise and govern the functioning of the Society.
